14th Annual AWS Fantasy of Lights Begins Tomorrow

November 25, 2008 - Fort Wayne, Ind. – The AWS Fantasy of Lights begins its 14th season tomorrow at Franke Park. Proceeds from the holiday themed light show go to the AWS Foundation whose mission is to help children and adults with disabilities live as independently as possible, be included in society and function at their maximum potential. This year's event starts at 5:45 pm. with a visit from Santa and Mrs. Claus. Every year Santa and Mrs. Claus turn on the lights to get the event started. This year they will have some help from some special children that receive therapies through AWS' Infant & Toddler Services program. Santa, Mrs. Claus and the children will ride through the park in a horse-drawn carriage with the children to kick-off the event.

Fantasy of Lights is open from November 26 through New Year's Eve, including all holidays. Visitors will see over 75 illuminated and animated displays this year including old favorites and new displays.

Hours of operation for Fantasy of Lights are 6 – 9 p.m. Sunday through Thursday; 6 – 10 p.m. Friday and Saturday. Admission is \$5 per car, \$10 per passenger van and \$25 for buses and trolleys.
